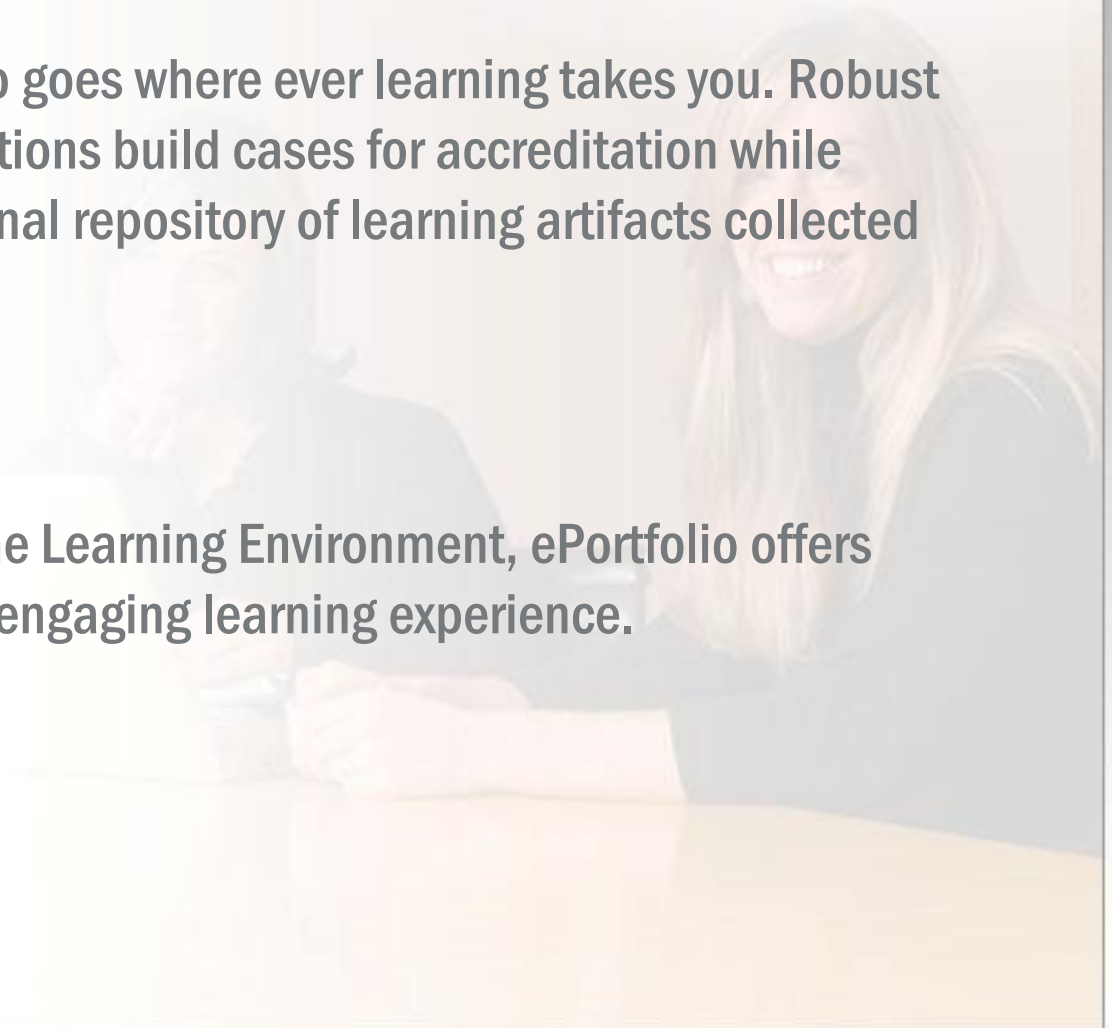

Tags: From this graph, and the equation, it can be seen that the speed of a series motor with no load torque will rise to infinity! This doesn't happen in practice because there is always a little load torque because due to friction in the motor. It can also be seen that as a little load torque is added to a series wound motor, the speed drops off very quickly to start with, but then drops off less quickly.	
With both motor field types, eventually, when the load torque becomes even larger, say when a stronger robot is pushing us backwards, the motor speed becomes negative (the motor starts rotating backwards).	
In practice, the speed line for a PM or shunt wound motor may not be a straight due to frictional loads which are not linearly dependant on speed.
